RECONFIRMATION MEETING FOR NOVEMBER, 2020

Reconfirm instructional delivery method: (Overall statement)

Our district will be continuing with the current offerings for instruction through the end of 2020. We are currently examining survey data, requirements, staff health as well as several factors related to COVID-19 to see if we are able to offer in-person instruction for grades 7-12 for second semester.

We have used the survey data from families to ensure we have a plan to make the requested adjustments for families with students in Grades BK-6 for second semester and we are now confident we can accomplish this. We do realize some families may change their minds as January approaches, but we needed to examine the feasibility and staffing as well as busing to be sure we can make this happen.

As part of that process, however, we did realize that we need to ask the Board to close the Schools of Choice option for the remainder of the school year. This window typically opens back up in January, but we are getting so many calls that it is clear we are not able to accommodate the current demand safely. This is on the agenda for discussion this month and action in December.

We also have a new idea for an improved schedule for the second semester for students in Grades 7-12. There would be fewer conflicts and also allow for the chance for some weekly time in person. We are still vetting this idea and hope to share a plan with the Board in December.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Elementary (Grades BK - 5): Offering in-person and online options for all students with Dansville teachers.

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Offering in-person and online options for 6th grade students with Dansville teachers.

For Grades 7 and 8, we are offering online courses with Dansville teachers as well as opportunities to come into the building for in-person small group instruction and support via Sign Up Genius. Offering Aggie Aid Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6-8 pm and Saturdays from 10 am – 2 pm.

High School (Grades 9 - 12): For Grades 9-12, we are offering online courses with Dansville teachers as well as opportunities to come into the building for in-person small group instruction only if students meet the exception criteria in the most recent MDHHS order. We are also offering Aggie Aid Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6-8 pm and Saturdays from 10 am – noon only for students who meet the exception criteria.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

We did bring back our students who are in the elementary behavior intervention room in-person full time as well as students in Grades 6-12 who are in the Aggie Room, where they receive significant special education support. All other students with an IEP have been offered either in-person or online supports, in compliance with their IEP goals.

Several at-risk students in Grades 7-12 have also been offered the chance to work in the building. This offer has also been extended to students who are unable to secure reliable internet at home.
