

Dansville Elementary School January Board Update

- FAST Bridge and Spring Math screening has been in full swing the past two weeks. This is an important time to get a quick check on student progress as we compare their results to their fall data. Decisions will then be made about additional interventions needed to support student growth such as Summer School, classroom interventions, and/or time with an Instructional Aide.
- After twelve years of using Reading Street as a literacy curriculum, a committee met this fall to review new curriculums. After analyzing five different programs, the choices were narrowed down to EL Education and Bookworms. Seven teachers will be piloting these programs in February and March to decide on a new literacy curriculum for DES. We thank all the teachers for their extra work in this process.
