

Dansville Middle School Board Report:

At the beginning of October, Middle School Science teachers received professional development on a science curriculum, called Amplify, Ingham County schools received a grant from the ISD to pilot. Teachers spent half their day learning from an Amplify consultant, and the other half aligning their learning targets with the new curriculum.

Middle School Principal, Erin Graf, received certification for CPI (Crisis Prevention Institute) which is a nonviolent crisis prevention training program to help equip staff members with the skills, confidence and effective framework to safely manage and prevent difficult behavior from students in school settings.

Monday, October 14 interviews were conducted to hire an assistant to our Secondary Math Interventionist, Sara Oesterle. The school hired Tonya Richie, a Dansville parent and current EduStaff sub for the district. She will be working with Sara Oesterle to assist in implementing Spring Math individual interventions in the secondary setting.
